COMPOSER'S NOTES

"Mundus invisibilis" in Latin means "The Invisible World".

String quartet with 2 electronic tracks.

TRACK 1: (Robot voice)

"The real world is invisible. Mycelium produces small molecules that it gently and with supreme precision assembles into complex structures - so small that they are invisible to the human eye.

As the mycelium grows, it assembles a dense network of long, microscopic fibres that stretch through the substrate like a superhighway system.

Once the mycelium has fully built its network, it transitions into its next stage: building a mushroom".

TRACK 2: Starts simultaneously with the first bar of the score.

Non vibrato, vibrato only where specified.
